

Sherpa's Referral Scheme

- Credit will be added to the invited user's account upon successful sign-up and mobile number verification.
- The referrer will receive credit after the invited user completes their first paid lesson in a regular booking.
- A referral is valid only if the invited user registers using the referrer's unique invitation link.
- Invited users must not have previously registered with Sherpa.
- Sherpa reserves the right to suspend referrers or invited users if misuse of the referral scheme is suspected.
- Referral credit will not be awarded if the referred user shares the same IP address as the referrer or is an immediate family member.
- Sherpa credit cannot be exchanged for cash or cash equivalents.
- Credit may be revoked in cases of suspicious activity by either the referrer or the invited user; this decision is final and binding.
- Sherpa may change the terms and conditions for awarding credit at any time, including the amounts awarded, and may suspend the referral system without notice.
- Only one credit voucher may be used per lesson, and credit is only applicable to regular bookings not one-off or flexible lessons.
- Credit awarded may be divided into smaller amounts across multiple vouchers, requiring use over multiple lessons.
